

There are 2 categories:

1) Membership in WARF is open to those University retirees who meet the qualifications to retire as “faculty” as described in Article 35: Retirement of the current WMU-AAUP contract for their date of hire. These qualifications include the required full-time service in a Board-appointed, ranked faculty position and holding tenure in an academic department at the University prior to the effective date of retirement.

2) Associate Membership in WARF is open to surviving Spouses/Partners of WARF members and others invited by the Steering Committee. Associate members have all benefits of membership except voting and serving as board members.

Dues Members and Associate Members must pay annual dues for the period January through December. Dues are set by the WARF Steering Committee. Annual dues (\$10) are to be paid through the WMU-AAUP. Members and Associate Members remain “active” as long as annual dues are paid.
